Arrowhead Transit is owned and operated by AEOA, and has been serving Minnesota's Arrowhead Region since 1974.

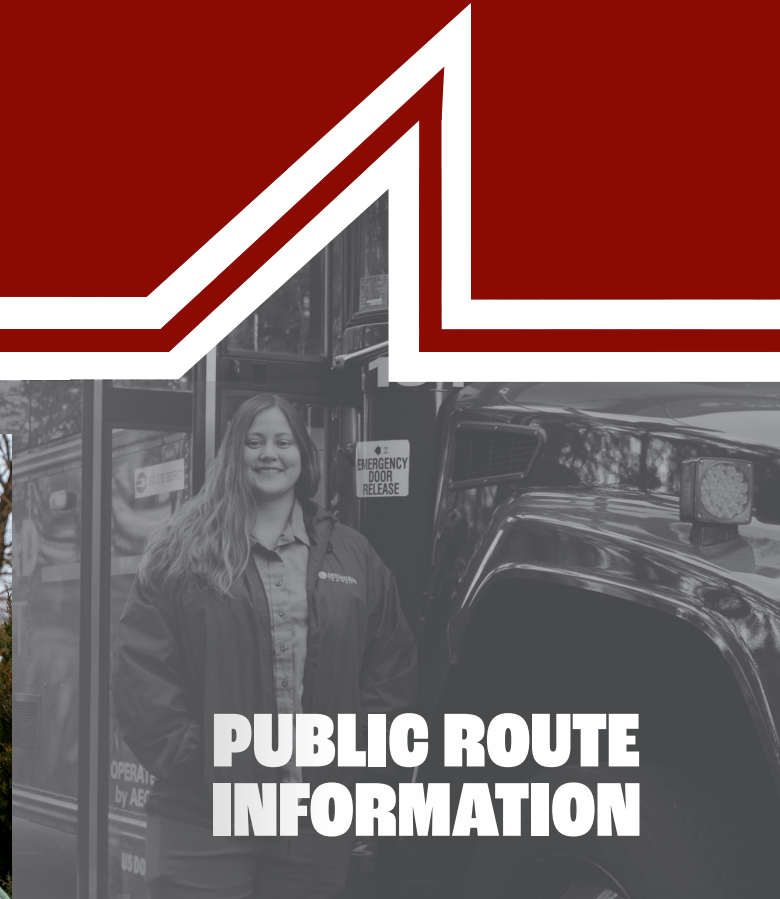

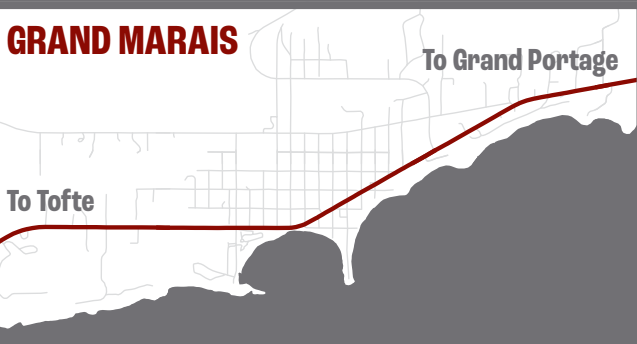
